Proposed Zoning Change

From GR – Community Commercial district is intended for office and commercial uses serving neighborhood and community needs, including both unified shopping centers and individually developed commercial sites, and typically requiring locations accessible from major traffic ways.

To LO-MU- Limited Office district is intended for offices predominately serving neighborhood or community needs, which may be located within or adjacent to residential neighborhoods. MU – Mixed Use combining district is intended for combination with selected base districts, in order to permit any combination of office, retail, commercial, and residential uses within a single development.

This application is scheduled to be heard by the Zoning and Platting Commission on September 6, 2005. The meeting will be held at City Hall Council Chambers, 301 West 2nd Street beginning at 6:00 p.m.

You are being notified because City Ordinance requires that all property owners within 300 feet of the proposed development and affected neighborhood organizations be notified when an application is scheduled for a public hearing.
