### Want to keep up with the Neighborhood Scoop?? Join our email "Yahoo!Group" – it's easy (honest!)

- First, register as a Yahoo! Groups member by going to our Yahoo webpage: <a href="http://groups.yahoo.com/group/SouthLamarNA/">http://groups.yahoo.com/group/SouthLamarNA/</a>.
- Once there, click on the "Join This Group" button (you only have to complete the **required** information).
- It will tell you to create a **Yahoo ID** and **Password** and enter the **email address** you want to use (Yahoo offers free email accounts, if you don't already have an email account elsewhere or if you want to create one specifically for SLNA activity).
- Note: it may take a day or two for your Yahoo ID to be processed and your residency in SLNA to be verified. You can not take the next step until you receive email notification welcoming you as a Yahoo!Group member.
- Once you are a Yahoo!Group member, go back to the same website (above) and sign in with your Yahoo ID and password (you will remember them, won't you?!).
- Click on "Edit My Membership", where you'll set your preferences for how to read the SLNA emails (i.e., in your email Inbox, or by going to the SLNA Yahoo! Group site).
- On the SLNA Yahoo!Group website, you can:
  - Review all messages ever posted, arranged as you wish: by date or by "thread" (subject), or search for messages containing "keywords" you enter.
  - ♦ Send individual emails to other SLNA subscribers: Click on the "Members" link at left, and scroll thru the list of subscribers (some profiles do not show who they are, but most do). While Yahoo will not reveal any one individual's entire email address, it will allow you to send them an email from the website. Hopefully, they will reply favorably to you!
  - ♦ You can always change these preferences at any time, or even quit this Yahoo!Group if you want.

Personally, I think it's a great way to keep up with your neighborhood, even if you never "post" any messages yourself. The SLNA Officers regularly "post" announcements received from civic groups, the City, quarterly meetings with APD, and any other news that can't wait till the next newsletter! So, join us online, won't you!?!
